Subject: Exemption Conditions for IMO 2020 Fuel Requirements

Circular Letter No. 2022

13 August 2022

- 1. As per the decision of the International Maritime Organization (IMO), all ships of 400 GT and above shall use maritime fuels with maximum sulfur content of 0.5 percent, from 01 January 2020, or will otherwise be prevented from operating. Moreover, the carriage of non-compliant fuels on ships shall be prohibited as of 01 March 2020.
- 2. Considering the above obligations, and in order to provide an opportunity for compliance with the IMO 2020 Requirements, while minimizing possible shortcomings for the maritime industry as a result, the Ports and Maritime Organization (PMO) as the duly authorized maritime administration of the Islamic Republic of Iran hereby extends the exemptions issued for vessels operating within the jurisdiction and sovereignty of this country from 02 June 2022 for a period of six months, under the following conditions:
 - A. All Iranian-flagged vessels operating within the jurisdiction and sovereignty of this country, and engaged in activities as FPSOs, FSUs, lay-up in anchorage, support for engineering and technical operations at sea, and the like will be exempt from complying with the IMO 2020 Requirements (0.5 percent sulfur content) for a period of six months;
 - B. All vessels conducting cabotage activities, and foreign-flagged vessels owned by Iranian entities, operating within the jurisdiction and sovereignty of this country, will be exempt from complying with the IMO 2020 Requirements (0.5 percent sulfur content) for a period of six months, provided that their Iranian ownership be ascertained and confirmed by the Iranian Ports and Maritime Organization (PMO);
 - C. All foreign-flagged vessels navigating in the Iranian waters, or entering Iranian ports, shall comply with the IMO 2020 Requirements (0.5 percent sulfur content);
 - D. All Iranian-flagged vessels conducting international voyages shall comply with the IMO 2020 Requirements (0.5 percent sulfur content); and
